The LSCBs are running two conferences to provide key updates, debate and share new ideas across the diverse safeguarding agenda. The conferences will support the delivery of the priorities and obsessions of both boards with a focus on risk and supplementary themes of child sexual abuse, child sexual exploitation and neglect. The content of each conference will be the same.

At each conference there will be keynote speeches on neglect and personal resilience along with a presentation on the Pan-Dorset MASH. The Dorset Young Researchers will also present the findings from some of their recent research.

During the day there will be opportunities for attendees to take part in two practical 45 minute workshops including:

- Understanding and responding to families from different cultures
- Exploring the difference between CSE and CSA (Bournemouth event only)
- Using tools in neglect
- Understand NICE guidelines about suicide and self-harm
- Working effectively with families in order to make a long-term change (Dorset event only)

Attendees will also have the opportunity to visit the marketplace of stalls from service providers and organisations such as BASPCAN who have been invited to provide further information to support the conference themes. There will be plenty of opportunities to network with colleagues throughout each event.

There will be a charge to statutory agencies of £50 to attend the conferences. Free places are available for charities. Places are limited at each event and it is advisable to book early.
